## What we are learning

Reading: We started City of Ember for our science fiction unit. Ms. Esquivel started the unit by explaining components of science fiction. They will be looking for these elements in both City of Ember and their literature circle books. Literature Circles will look a little different as students have to journal 5-7 sentences about their reading each night.

Writing: We wrapped up personal narratives this week and they are ready to be displayed for conferences! So please come check them out! We will begin teaching persuasive essays next!

English: Students wrapped up the unit on adjectives this week. Students will be completing a quick unit on punctuation and capitalization, which they are already very familiar with! We will continue to dialogue sentences next week.

Religion: Students wrote many thank you letters to individuals during Catholic Schools week and also participated in many fun activities! They took their oral test over the Penitential Rite and will be practicing the Memorare this month. Students will be picking back up with the sacrament of Confirmation next week.

Social Studies: Students worked on individual landforms slides to create a class presentation. They will be starting their Maya, Aztec, and Inca unit next week.

Science: Students are continuing to learn about life science. They discussed how energy flows through a food web. We will be looking more into photosynthesis and decomposers in the next few weeks.
