What we are learning

Reading: City of Ember

As a class, we are finishing up reading <u>The City</u> of <u>Ember</u> by Jeanne DuPrau. We will continue to learn reading strategies that will carry over to our fantasy unit while reading this book. Students have started their fantasy literature circle books and will continue to journal nightly on their own.

Writing: You may have been hearing the zoo debate at home. Should there be zoos? Yes or No? We are starting our first persuasive essay on the topic. We will learn the parts of a persuasive essay and they eventually they will have to read it on their own.

English: Students are finishing a chapter on punctuation and capitalization. Next, we will move on to learn about pronouns. During this unit, students will create games about pronouns to play with each other, reinforcing the skills they will be learning.

Religion: Currently, we are learning about the sacrament of Confirmation. We will also be learning more about the stations of the cross. On Friday, March 10th we will be leading the school in stations of the cross. Feel free to join us at 2:00!

Social Studies: We started the students' favorite chapter on the Maya, Aztec, and Incas. Currently we are just studying the Aztec civilization and their many interesting inventions!

Science: As part of our Life Science unit we are giving deeper into the study of plants. We are learning about parts, meaning and function of the plant. We also created group presentations on the process of photosynthesis.
