Extra Practice for Brain Bucks!

MOBYMAX.COM IS A GREAT RESOURCE THAT HOLY TRINITY OFFERS STUDENTS. THESE PAST TWO WEEKS STUDENTS HAVE TAKEN PLACEMENT TESTS IN MATH AND LANGUAGE. THEY WILL ALSO BE LOOKING AT THEIR RIT SCORES FROM THE FALL MAP TEST AND COMPLETING A PLACEMENT TEST FOR THEIR GOAL AREA: EITHER VOCABULARY, INFORMATIONAL TEXT, OR FICTIONAL TEXT. THE PLACEMENT TESTS STARTS STUDENTS AT THEIR INSTRUCTIONAL LEVEL AND MOVES THEM THROUGH LESSONS AT THEIR OWN PACE. STUDENTS ARE GIVEN TIME TO WORK ON THIS AT SCHOOL, BUT ALSO ARE ENCOURAGED TO PRACTICE AT HOME. FOR EACH LESSON COMPLETED AT HOME, STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE \$20 IN BRAIN BUCKS.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES TO EARN BRAIN BUCKS INCLUDE COMPLETING TENMARKS.COM LESSONS FOR \$60, WRITING BOOK REVIEWS ON BIBLIONASIUM.COM AND SHARING THEM WITH THEIR CLASSMATES, AND PARTICIPATING IN ESSAY CONTESTS. CURRENTLY STUDENTS CAN PARTICIPATE IN A SCHOLASTIC ESSAY CONTEST ABOUT SHAKING THINGS OFF THAT MAY HURT OUR FEELINGS. THIS ESSAY IS DUE DEC. 3 AND STUDENTS CAN EARN \$200, AND POSSIBLY A CHANCE TO MEET TAYLOR SWIFT. 😊
